As a **Global Community Ambassador**, you'll lead the creation of new regional groups — connecting people, inspiring action, and bringing the weltwärts Community to life in your region.

Requirements

- English (spoken & written) plus local language according to region
- Residence in one of the listed countries
- Completed weltwärts volunteer service
- Availability for onboarding (Nov 15/16) and workshop (Nov 20, 2025)

Your Main Responsibilities

1. Build and Strengthen the Network of former volunteers

Be a key contact person for alumni in your region. Reach out proactively, support local networking, share relevant opportunities (weltwärts offers, workshops, community fund, scholarships, trainings), and activate existing networks.

2. Organize Local & Regional Meetups

- Plan and host **1–2 low-threshold in-person gatherings** in your area.
- Identify and support former volunteers in other countries of your region who want to network

3. Facilitate Digital Exchange

- Organize **2–3 cross-country online meetings** for networking and peer learning.
- Connect recently returned alumni with more experienced ones.
- Encourage exchange on post-volunteer experiences, project ideas, and collaborations.

4. Check-ins & Reporting

- Participate in **bi-monthly check-ins** and share updates on your regional activities.
- Document progress and learnings in a shared Google Doc.

What We Offer

- **Workshops** for Global Community Ambassadors (sharing knowledge, skills, and tools plus integrating your own topics of interest).
- Continuous support through digital check-ins, personal communication (WhatsApp, Signal, etc.), and access to resources like Zoom, the weltwärts newsletter, WWN, and Canva.
- Networking with other ambassadors in Germany and globally staying connected to the weltwärts world beyond your volunteer service.
- Certificate of participation as a Global Ambassador for the weltwarts Community.
- Advisory support available through glokal e.V.
